- **12349:** 1 = standard as a whole demonstrates the time management aspect of self-management strategies to organise personal life.
- 4249: 1 = standard demonstrates self-management in terms of the working aspect of personal life.
- 496: 1 = standard as a whole demonstrates self-management strategies to maintain well-being.
- **7117:** 1, 3 = this standard demonstrates understanding of personal well-being factors (outcome 2). Provides goals (outcome 3) to enable reflection. Standard demonstrates reflection though the identification of factors that affect the ability to learn (outcome 1).
- **7117 & 7118:** 1 = these two standards combine to demonstrate self-management strategies to continue learning.
- **526**: 2 = standard as a whole demonstrates knowledge of community services agencies and the ability to match these to different situations.
- **4247**: 2 = standard as a whole demonstrates ability to describe different cultures of people in New Zealand. The ability to identify and understand cultural differences provides the basis for positive interactions with people from other cultures.
- 377: 2 = standard demonstrates ability of learners to describe interpersonal/workplace relationships in a diverse workplace. The learner is also required to describe strategies to support positive workplace relationships (ER 1.4).
- **3503: 2 = standard demonstrates ability of learners to interact in a group.**
- **543**: 2 = standard demonstrates ability of learners to work in a workplace, which will involve interaction with others (outcome 3). The 'new workplace' aspect supports the employment pathway of the qualification, i.e. learners able to work in entry-level roles.
- **10780**: 2 = standard requires reflection on existing ability of learners to interact in a workplace (outcome 2). The learner is also required to demonstrate timeliness which supports personal self-management (ER 1.4). The 'work experience placement' aspect supports the employment pathway of the qualification, i.e. learners able to work in entry-level roles. Standard requires reflection on the work placement (outcome 3).
- **10781**: 1, 3 = standard overall identifies goals related to future directions which can include career related goals. Standard demonstrates reflection though the preparation of a personal profile (outcome 1). Depending on the goals of the learner it may also demonstrate personal management in terms of self-management for goals related to continuing learning (outcome 2, 3).
- **266 literacy units**: 4 = the three standards cover literacy skills in range of contexts (naturally occurring evidence).
- **266 numeracy units**: 4 = the three standards cover numeracy skills in range of contexts (naturally occurring evidence).
- **3483, 10790, 3501, 9680, 24709**: 4 = these standards cover different aspects of literacy and numeracy and provide options for learners to complete the qualification outcome in a choice of contexts.
